

Ishi Archery Club, Inc.
Meeting Notes
Thursday, April 9, 2009

The meeting was called to order by President Pierre Peets. Those attending were Jeanne George, Leland George, Pierre Peets, Mike Casteel, Bill Peterson, Jim Humphreys ??? (add others; attendance sheet lost)

Approval was given for the February 16th minutes; March 9th meeting lacked quorum of Board members to conduct business; no meeting was held.

Jeanne shared the CBH/SAA News – March & April issues and flyers for tournaments. Mailed charter renewal listing Heins, P. Raglin, L. George, Peets, Gipson, LaBoudour, Peterson and Wagner as current NFAA members. Mike Casteel is also with a June expiration date. The web site is now online at <http://www.ishiarcheryclub.org>. The bank balance is \$18,163.19 as of March 31, 2009. Jeanne submitted a 2008 overview of expense and income by activity. Bills submitted and approved for CBH/SAA Charter \$40; Norms Printing \$42.11; Jeanne George (postage) \$16.80; and Range Inspection to NFAA \$15. The February 27th bank balance was \$16,158.07. Deposits from indoor & membership were \$465. Bills submitted were \$680 for fair rental; \$700 for Pacific Bale Butts; \$52.03 to Leland for range improvements; \$21.43 & 56.84 for Norm's Printing and \$40 for CBH/SAA charter club dues.

Youth Program will continue on Wednesday afterschool and evening. Currently only have about 6 participating. Summer League is in full swing with 12 – 26 nightly. Leland will call membership for scheduling the Rodeo Parking the week of April 13th.

The Indoor Shoot attendance averaged 22 youth & 18 club. It was crowded in late February and then the attendance dropped off for the club members. Consider having an early and a late shooting times to accommodate membership.

There were 105 shooters at the March 15th Tournament. It was a windy and cold day. The March 22nd Youth Shoot was a success with 29 shooters. Lots of sponsorships for door prizes for youth. Recommendation to have only two arrows on the field round.

The May 17th Tournament was finalized ... targets for repair to Phil; Jim will arrange to clean toilets; approval given for Pierre to purchase supplies to tile Chicken Shack floor; Pierre will purchase food; Jeanne will handle registration and print more FS cards; no one volunteered to do a raffle; awards are OK; Flyers to clubs/shops & postcard to past shooters have been mailed. Work parties will be May 9th and 16th.

The Bylaws has been reviewed by Jesse and further edited by Jeanne based upon current practices. A draft was presented. It was suggested we have a January – December membership. Send any other suggestions to Jeanne for consideration at the next meeting. To be voted upon at a future club meeting after being posted on the web for 30 or more days.

Purchase of supplies to build additional target stands for practice range. Rod and Bill will make prototypes for stands on practice range. Upon approval of design, will hold a work

party to build stands as an assembly line. Pierre will explore roofing as a cover for practice stands. Leland and Pierre will explore netting as a back stop on the 20 yard range.

There was no interest to organize a practice 3-D shoot for April 30th for pre-Trail Shoot attendees.

Approval was given to have again an archery shooting booth a the Tehama District Fair on September 24-27, 2009. Pierre will try to get free balloons from Wal-Mart.

The next club meeting will be on the 2nd Thursday after shooting in May at the range.
