

Ishi Archery Club, Inc.
MEETING NOTES
Thursday, January 14, 2010

The meeting was called to order by Leland George, President, at 7:25 PM. Those attending were Leland George, Stacy Pearce, Phil Raglin, Jesse Sisneros, Jason Zumalt, Pierre Peets, Jeanne George, Robert Dover, and Bill Peterson.

Motion was made and passed to approve the **December 3rd minutes**. The secretary shared the CBH/SAA News for January 2010; reported that a club newsletter for Winter 2010 was mailed and e-mailed to all current members; there are **70 families** as of today; Jeanne & Leland will be attending the CBH/SAA Annual Banquet on January 23rd; the liability insurance for 2010 has been paid; and the range inspections are current.

A motion was made and passed to have the **current officers** of President, Vice President, Secretary and Treasurer as the bank account signatures. Jeanne will submit the minutes for both meetings and let the officers know when they can go to the bank to sign the forms.

No Treasurer's Report was given. Jesse requested an **end of year financial statement** so he can file the IRS/State tax forms. Jesse & Bill volunteered and were appointed as the **audit committee** to review the 2010 treasurer books.

Indoor Shoots – the youth nights are averaging 20 and on club nights about 12. There will be no shoots week of Jan. 25; need to dismantle Friday, Jan 22, if needed, and re-set on Wednesday, Feb 3rd. Leland will contact the Bull Sale Committee about clearing the hall.

The next **work party** will be January 23rd; Bill will check his calendar to select dates for February and March; approval was given for a Club BBQ at work parties. Robert has volunteered to coordinate the BBQ with Bill. The Wednesday AM work parties are continuing at 9 AM – 12 noon at the range; rain cancels.

Jesse, as a member of the **Range Committee**, provided a summary of repairs needed on the range. Jesse will add the 'to do' list to the white board at the range. In summary, 34 bow racks are needed, redo 6 butts, and reverse 2 butts on the field and hunter rounds. See attached spread sheet. Bill reported that Jim Humphrey & Rich Reynolds have inventoried the 3-D Targets and the smaller ones beyond repair will be made into a backstop by Raglin 3-D.

Some suggestions were made to assign a target to EVERY member; and it was reported that Don Gipson is planning to repair the bridge on #3; and Jim Beall is installing the new bow racks.

Plans for **Practice Range** were discussed and the consensus was as follows:

- have a flat level cemented area for all of the shooting stations
- shooting stations will be 10, 20 (3), 30, etc to 100 (every 10 yards)
- shooting stations will be at 5 yard increments, if possible, especially beyond 50 yards i.e. 55, 65, 70, 75, etc.
- preference given to the 5 yard increments shooting stations on left; 10 yard on right; upside down 'v'
- all shooting stations will have a shade cover

Phil volunteered to chair the committee to finalize the plans and move forward. The first steps will be to set up the shooting line, determine the placement of the butts, and ground work

needed. Bill volunteered to be on the committee. Others are invited. Contact Phil if you are interested.

Discussion was held regarding the **placement of storage containers**. It has been suggested to move them by the Chicken Coop. A decision needs to be made so the National Guard can be instructed if they have a work party. Bill and Leland have priced another container for non-target items; 20 feet length; \$2400 delivered. Another 40' container would be \$3600. Both topics were tabled for further discussion.

Bill and Jon Ward will follow up about scheduling another work party with the **National Guard**.

Our next **invitational tournament** will be held March 21st. It will be a 28 target; 2 arrow shoot. Jeanne will inventory the registration supplies and awards; Jim & Rich will be in charge of the 3-D targets; Robert will handle the food concessions (buy food and serve). The registration fees were revised as follows:

Flyers will be mailed to local archery shops and postcard to previous shooters. Discussion was held how more club members can be encouraged to help at the tournaments ... any club member that shoots at the tournament should be required to help set up and/or clean up? Only a few members are actually needed during the shooting times. It is the set up and clean up that needs more help! No decision was made.

The 2nd Annual Ishi Club **Invitational Youth Only Shoot** will be held on March 28th. Youth Shooters must be supervised by an adult; \$5 per shooter; 28 targets; 2 arrows each with 3-D and specialty paper targets. Ishi pins will be awarded by age and equipment types. Leland will contact the 4-H instructors to finalize and assist during the day. Jeanne will again solicit door prizes for all youth attending.

Ishi Club has the opportunity to earn some funds at the **Red Bluff Round Up** – Trinity Parking Lot - April 12-16 (\$1500) and April 16 or 17 (\$500 each day). Final decision as to adding a day or two will be further discussed at the February meeting. Twelve adults are needed on the Friday or Saturday to park cars. Motion was made and approved that all funds earned will go towards general funds i.e. range maintenance.

Phil has donated 18 more **metal cans for trash** at the range. Thank you Phil!

Additional discussion was held about having more club dinners w/o shooting to get better acquainted; learn more about members' careers/talents to help at the range work parties, and have an appreciation dinner for those who help at work parties, etc. Another suggestion was to have club shoots and/or qualifying NFAA rounds following the work parties

The next meeting will be held on **Thursday, February 11th at 7: 30 PM** at the Ron Knight Building, Fairgrounds. The meeting was adjourned at 8:45 PM.
