

**Ishi Archery Club, Inc.**  
**Meeting Minutes**  
**Wednesday, June 30, 2010**

The meeting was called to order at 7:30 PM by President Leland George. The May 13<sup>th</sup> meeting minutes were approved. The CBH/SAA News for June 2010 is available on the web under our web page links. Currently, there are 37 households; new cards available tonight. New & Renewals payable now ... \$35 family, \$30 individuals & \$15 students. The secretary will continue to post tournament flyers as received on range information board

The bank balance was \$18,152.55 as of May 28, 2010. With final deposits & expenses for the tournament, the balance is \$18,509.65 according to Phil's handout. No additional bills were submitted for payment.

The Wednesday AM work parties are cancelled until the weather is cooler. No reports were given from the Range Committee or 3-D Targets Committee. The Practice Range was discussed. Pierre & Jon will contact 'friends' about leveling the area to build the shelter/shade structure. Permission was given to James to purchase a 40' storage container ASAP. Maximum costs \$3,000. Marty will also check with PG& E for a possible donation of one.

Bill Heins, James & Rachel Buckley attended the **CBH/SAA Cascade Regional Meeting** at Luigi's in Red Bluff on June 11<sup>th</sup>. Paradise, Straight Arrow, and Ishi were represented. Legislative issues were discussed regarding CA elk hunting and other political issues of interest to archery. The state organization are promoting a membership drive.

Our **May 16th Tournament** had 169 shooters and the results were posted on the web site. The income was \$2,645 fees, \$807.41 food concessions and \$90 T-shirt sales.

**The Summer League** has had about 12 participants nightly. James Buckley and Jon Ward will continue until August or until there is no interest.

It was decided to NOT have the archery booth at the **Tehama District Fair**. The dates September 23-26, 2010 conflict with hunting and it has been too difficult to find persons available to help during the days. It was good publicity for the club especially the youth program.

**The 2011 Tournament Dates** were finalized as follows: March 20 – Youth Shoot; March 27 – Spring Fling; and May 15 – Rock Festival. Both of the open tournaments will have 42 targets.

James made a motion and Jon seconded it to give the new **Crooked Arrow Archery Club** the 13 target shelters from the Chico/Chester Club. Approved.

Jim Rice will set prices, styles and a new design for t-shirt and hat sales. Approved. A preshrink cotton shirt is preferred. Marty will see about window decals.

A tentative date for the **club turkey shoot** is Saturday, November 20<sup>th</sup>. Leland will finalize plans and make sure this date does not conflict with Straight Arrow.

It was decided to continue the Indoor Shoot at the fairgrounds. It will be decided if Wednesday or Thursday will be the club night. Youth will do the other night, if interest. The indoor will begin in December (first week?) with a holiday club dinner and free shoot. Jon is willing to BBQ again. The cost will be \$5.00 for Ishi members and \$6.00 for guests.

Don requested that our tournaments follow CBH/SAA classifications including Master Senior. It was voted that Ishi would not recognize the Master Senior class. There are only a few currently that participate at our tournaments. Leland would like to appoint Don, Zack, and Mike H. as a tournament committee or as he called it the 'brain trust'. If anyone would like to organize a club shoot, volunteer and let people know via the e-mails or newsletter.

The next meeting will be in October. The date, time and location will be announced on the web site and in a newsletter.
