MEETING MINUTES
Thursday, May 13, 2010

The April 8th meeting minutes were approved. The CBH/SAA News for May 2010 was shared. Currently, there are 43 Family, 30 Individuals & 5 Student memberships for a total of 78 households. New & Renewals payable now - \$35 family, \$30 individuals & \$15 students. The secretary will send out notice & newsletter in early June. The tournament flyers have been posted on range bulletin board.

The current **bank balance** was \$13,278.43 as of April 30th. No bills were submitted for approval. Don would like to have 1/2 of carpet bale at his garage from the cutters; he paid them \$50. Approved.

Work Parties are scheduled for May 15 and every Wednesday 9 AM; 8 members attended May 8th work party. The **Range Committee** submitted an update. **3-D Targets Committee** reported that the target are numbered and bagged for the tournament. No update on the Practice Range. Leland & James will follow up on the storage container purchase. The **youth program** ends May 26; only a few have been attending. The Vista Middle School SERRF afterschool program will continue with a field trip to range on Monday, May 24th 2-4 PM. Leland, Jeanne & Jesse have been volunteering. **Special thanks** to the Red Bluff Round Up – Trinity Parking Lot participants Jim Humphrey, Pierre Peets, Jesse Sisneros, Jeremy Haley, Robert Dover, Jim Rice, Zach Rice, and Don Cornelius. The job was a lot easier than in past years. \$1500 was received. No decision was made regarding participating in 2011.

A motion was made by Don and seconded by James to install **permanent markers** for the 3-D targets. Approved. Jim H. will provide a list of distances and targets.

Our next event is the **May 16th Tournament**. Leland will honor Barbara Heins. At the work party, we need to weed eat, clean registration & food concessions, repair and set up back stops, put 3-D targets in place & measure shooting positions. Inventory of Awards & Supplies for registration are OK. Registration will begin at 7 AM. Jeanne & Cheryl would like others to help. Jesse & Bill Dahl will assist. Might try to computerize if generator will support computer & printer. The 3-D targets have been inventory & selected. Robert Dover will be purchasing food; he will offer Pulled Pork Sandwiches. Jim R. volunteered to run food concession and Robert will do the chicken shack. Jon, James & Jim H. will monitor the targets throughout the day. Jon and James will also direct parking to decrease the fire danger. We will allow smoking only in gravel areas. No alcohol on the range while shooting! Need everyone to help with enforcing. No beer as a donation to club! Bring portable radios. Be aware of rattlesnakes!

The **Summer League** has had about 15-20 participants per night. Will deposit \$265 for three nights. Motion made and seconded to change the night to Wednesdays because of some members are not available on Thursdays. Approved. It will begin first week of June giving time to announce in newsletter.

There was no interest to have an archery booth at the **Fourth of July Celebration** at Tehama District Fairgrounds.

Tehama District Fair is September 23-26, 2010. No interest expressed to continue the Archery Shooting Booth. Need a coordinator; paperwork due early July. Last year, only about \$200 was made after buying more arrows and a new bow and repairing the backstop. Good publicity for the club; but limited new memberships.

Request was made to have someone **re-grade the road** for \$200. Not approved.
