

Ishi Archery Club, Inc.
Meeting Minutes
Thursday, October 21, 2010

The meeting was called to order by President Leland George at 6:33 PM. Those attending were Jeanne George, Pierre Peets, Rod Swain, James Buckley, Leland George, and Phil Raglin.

The June 30th minutes were approved. Jeanne shared copies of the CBH/SAA News – September & October issues and the Archery (NFAA magazine) – August/September issue. She questioned the annual Business Filings Division Statement of Information and \$235 filing fee. She will contact Jesse and Phil will get a copy of the 2009 paperwork. Memorial Service for Judi Hall, Dave Hall's wife, is Saturday, October 23rd at 11 AM at Straight Arrow Bowhunters, Redding. Dave is the current president of the Cascade Region CBH/SAA.

The web site is updated. Visit <http://www.ishiarcheryclub.org> often for latest information. The October meeting announcement was sent to all and e-mailed. Many e-mails were returned. Our current membership is 44 households. The 2011 Tournament dates were submitted to Cascade & CBH/SAA newsletter editor as March 27 (4th Sunday); March 20 (Youth Shoot); and May 15th (3rd Sunday). Jeanne will update our Indoor Shoot dates after this meeting.

The bank balance as of 9/30/2010 is \$18,625.02. Phil's accounting showed a balance of \$17,787.12. He will check his deposits, find the error and balance the books. Pierre submitted a bill for plywood and lumber for the shelving in the sheds for \$100.04. Phil inquired about additional deposits from the Summer League. He will contact Jon Ward.

Discussed the practice range and leveling it before the shade structure is built. According to James, Cresco Rentals in Redding will rent us a cat for 40 hours work for \$1500 during the off season. North Main Equipment has a cat we may be able to borrow if transport is available. Mike Casteer may be able to provide a low boy. Dudley's Excavation is another possibility. James, Leland & Pierre will all check on availability and report back. James has not purchased another 40' Storage Container yet. He will proceed. Pierre & Jim H. have been building shelves in the storage units; need a welder to cut vents to circulate air in the containers. Leland will check with Frank Moore about his portable welder. Rod is willing to make more platforms for the 3-D targets.

Leland reported the youth program will begin in January at the Indoor on Wednesday nights. There will also be a mandatory orientation for new youth on Wednesday, December 8th at Wetter Hall. He is recruiting more adults to help with the program to be certified 4-H archery leaders. He is willing to train at the volunteer's convenience. James expressed an interest. Max Fregoso has made a \$1,000 donation to the youth program. Pierre will contact him regarding use of the funds and our needs.

James made prototype pop up target that he is donating to the club to use as novelty shoot at the tournaments and with the youth program. Thank you James.

No work parties were scheduled. But, the Wednesday AM work parties will begin in November. There is no update on the donation of butts to Crooked Arrow. Leland will contact Jim H. to see where it stands. There was no report regarding the T-shirt & hat sales (Jim Rice), window decals (Marty) and Legislature Update (Bill Heins).

The long term lease with the county & BLM is moving forward. The county has requested finalization by early December and then a new contract will be updated with Ishi. There was an environmental report done that is only valid for 6 months. The BLM has requested protection of Indian artifacts and restricting roads in the area; the county may only use the land for an archery range.

The Club Turkey Shoot will be held Saturday, November 20th beginning at 9 AM. This activity is free to current members; \$6.00 for guests. Leland will contact Jim regarding ordering animal targets, etc. There will be 28 paper animal targets. We will set up at 9 AM and then shoot. The top shooter will receive a \$15 gift certificate at Raleys and then for every 5 participants based upon highest to lowest scores; no classes or styles.

The Indoor Shoot will be held on Thursday nights in December, January & February at the Ron Knight Building, Fairgrounds. Wednesday nights will be reserved for the youth program in January and February only. The building is not available the fourth week of January; Bull Sale. Leland will inventory and order targets; 5 spot, Vegas 3-spot and 40 cm indoor target face. We will continue to shoot at 20 yards. There was a discussion about 18 meters (19.6850 yds) to prepare for CBH/SAA Indoor championships but it was felt that 6 inches at that range would have little difference to most shooters. The cost will be \$5 members and \$6 guests; \$5 student both nights. Leland will arrange to have the building inspected as CBH approved indoor range. Pierre will figure a handicapped system. There was interest to develop teams based upon handicaps for awards. The league time would be at 7 PM with warm up beginning at 5 PM. We will discuss more at the next meeting.

The Club Holiday BBQ and Indoor Shoot will be Thursday, December 2nd at 6 PM at the Ron Knight Building, Fairgrounds. Meat & sodas will be provided. Jon Ward volunteered to get the tri tip and BBQ. Everyone is to bring a dish to share. Phil will purchase plastic ware and paper towels on his next trip to Costco. Jim Rice will be asked about getting more plates. After dinner, there will be free shooting for current members. All others must pay dues to be able to shoot and/or eat.

Those attending agreed to continue Rodeo Parking for the \$1500. It was easier last year and hopefully will be the same in 2011.

Rod has welding equipment that he is giving away. Pierre and Phil will take a look. If they take it Rod still wants the Ishi Club to be able to use it, if needed.

Leland & Jeanne visited the NFAA headquarters in Yankton, SD on their trip. The manager did not see why we could not have qualifying rounds with the 3-D targets if the distances and spots were similar. Leland plans to submit a petition to the State.

The 2011 Election of officers will be held at the December meeting. Anyone with an interest, please step forward.

The next club meeting will be held at 7:30 PM on December 2nd at Ron Knight Building, Fairgrounds. Thereafter, 2nd Wednesday or Thursday of Jan, Feb & March.

The meeting was adjourned at 8:42 PM.
