

Ishi Archery Club, Inc.
Meeting Notes
Thursday, October 8, 2009

The meeting was called to order at 6:05 PM at the range by Pierre Peets, President. Those attending were Don Gipson, Jon Ward, Tom Rahming, Rich Reynolds, Pierre Peets, Leland George, Bill Peterson, Jeanne George, George Wilson, and Jim Humphreys

Minutes of the April 9th, June 18th and September 10th meetings were approved as submitted. Jeanne shared the October issue of CBH/SAA News, announced flyers for shoots to be posted on bulletin boards & in mailbox, and requested \$235 filing fee be approved for the annual Business Filings Division Statement of Information. Approval was given. All newsletters & meeting notes have been posted on web site, and the recent Fall newsletter was sent to those with current e-mail addresses and also mailed to all; Hansen & Reynolds are invalid and returned e-mails. Current membership is 58 households. The 2010 Tournament dates were submitted to Cascade & CBH/SAA newsletter editor as March 14 (3rd Sunday); March 28 (Youth Shoot); and May 15th (3rd Sunday). She also reported she wrote a letter to Paradise about trading for May for April dates but no response.

According to the current bank statement, the checking account balance as of 9/30/2009 is \$18,105.17. Phil was not in attendance for a complete treasurer's report.

Leland reported that the youth programs will begin Wednesdays in January at 6 PM. There is a mandatory meeting for new members (4-H and Ishi) on Wednesday, November 18th at Wetter Hall. He reported that the new 4-H archery project proficiencies will be introduced. Pierre would like to see the high school club re-established. He was encouraged to contact the high school. All high school youth can join Ishi and be involved in the Wednesday youth nights for instruction during the Indoor League.

Work Parties are scheduled Saturdays Oct 17 & Nov 7 and Wednesdays 9 AM. The priority of tasks include 1st cut carpet & repair target butts; 2nd clean up grounds; 3rd finish registration booth addition and 4th restore the red flat bed trailer for a trash hauler. Other tasks as time permits are clean & rearrange items in sheds, inventory 3-D; finalize plans for practice range and roll the barb wire & gather the posts along the north fence line.

Tehama District Fair Archery Booth was successful. Thanks to all who helped. Phil reports a profit of \$700 without counting the repair of the backstop, arrow purchase and bow repair.

The revised Bylaws have been posted on the web site for review. It needs to be voted upon at future club meeting. Need to further discuss with Jesse about the revisions.

The Club Turkey Shoot will be held November 1st (rain date Nov 8) at 9 AM. It will be free to current members. Pierre will purchase NFAA paper animal targets. Pierre will contact Phil about gluing them on the boards and getting six \$15 gift certificates from Raleys. Set up will be at 9 AM.

We will set up the week of Dec 1-3 depending upon weather. Jim Humphrey will inventory and order targets. The cost will be \$5 members and \$10 guests; \$5.00 for student, both nights. Don and Jon will plan for awards ... team vs. individuals ... gift certificates, etc.

The Club Holiday BBQ and Indoor Shoot will be held at the Ron Knight Building, Fairgrounds on Thursday, December 3 at 6 PM; Bring dish to share and own table service. There will be a short business meeting to elect officers; and then free shooting for current members. Jon will purchase the tri tip from A&R Meats.

Pierre reported that BLM plans to make a map of the range. He continues to work with BLM to finalize the county contract.

Pierre reestablished the shooting positions on the Eastside to have 28 targets. They are marked by an orange/red marker as the shooting position and a green/pink as the target. He encouraged everyone to take a look and give feedback. The goal is to have 42 targets mostly shooting outward to the perimeter of the area.

The next club meeting will be held December 3rd at the Ron Knight Building, Fairgrounds following the club dinner.
