Meeting Notes
September 10, 2009

The meeting was called to order by Vice President Leland George at 6:15 PM. Those attending were Bill Peterson, Leland & Jeanne George, Rich Reynolds, Jim Humphreys and Pete Hernandez.

Jeanne reported we currently have 58 households; 39 non NFAA members. The previous meeting notes have been posted on the web site; she forgot to bring copies for approval. Either the past minutes or newsletters are not available on the web site; Jeanne will check and ask the webmaster to keep active. Pete has pictures of all 42 field targets that can be posted on the web site; he will send to Jeanne. No treasurer report was given. Jeanne has a bill to pay the Cascade dues; \$390. Phil has been in Oregon hunting.

The final plans for the Fair Booth were made. Leland and/or Jim will buy more staple guns and staples; more arrows were purchased; Leland will double check the bows for strings & arrow rests; balloons OK; Jim will check the compressor; Bill volunteered to call the membership to sign up for shifts; will purchase ice and water; people can call Jeanne at 524-7278 or Jim at 200-0259 for gate passes as they arrive. Set up will be Wednesday at 9 AM; meet at the fairgrounds.

The dates for the club turkey shoot were set ... Sunday, November 1st at 9 AM with a rain date of November 8th. There will be 28 paper animal targets. Highest score will win a turkey and every 5th person will also win. Turkeys will be \$15 gift certificates from Raleys. Club members ONLY and free!

The annual holiday dinner & shoot will be Thursday, December 3rd. Club members will shoot free; all others \$10. The club will buy a tri tip and others bring dishes to share. Bring own silverware and plates.

Indoor shoot to begin in December 10 & 17 and then January 7 thru February 25 (no shoot during bull sale). The youth nights will be Wednesdays beginning January 6th. The cost for participation will continue as \$5.00 for youth & club members; \$10 for guests.

The high school is not being promoted at the high school; little interest from staff or students. 4-H will have a mandatory meeting on November 18th. Leland, Bill, Jim, Pierre, and Jesse plan to continue as 4-H leaders.

No one present attended the June work party to map the eastside. Pierre continues to work with BLM and the county about the patent. We need to start working on the target layout if we are going to use the eastside for March or May 2010 tournaments.

Bill will contact Phil about finalizing the practice range. He will announce a work party when the weather cools off. Leland will contact Ken Warren about completing the registration addition. Again, a work party will be held when the weather is cooler. The group might start again on Wednesday mornings.
